Your Assessment Responsibilities & Final Deadline for CY23 (1/31)

What Is Expected of You: All PCC faculty and instructors (full-time and part-time) are expected to complete at least one assessment in at least one class each semester that you teach. You will pick a skill that you want to assess, score your students on a corresponding rubric, and enter those scores into our assessment software, elumen. Here are some examples of our esix college-wide assessment rubrics that are available for anyone to use!

When Your Assessments are <u>Due</u>: Assessment scores must be submitted into eLumen **by the grading deadline** each semester. However, we've extended the final deadline for *all calendar year 2023 assessments* (spring, summer, and fall) to <u>January 31</u>. Make sure to complete any past-due assessments for 2023 by the end of the month, and refer to the resources below if you need any help!

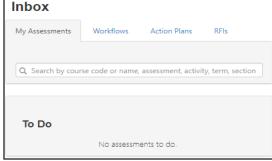
Assessment Awards Ceremony—SAVE THE DATE! 1/30 3:30PM (WebEx)

eLumen's New "Inbox" View
