Important End-of-Semester Reminders

What's Expected of Me?

All faculty and instructors are expected to complete at least one assessment in at least one class each semester you teach—more are encouraged!

When Is the Deadline?

Student assessment scores must be submitted via <u>eLumen</u> by the grading deadline—that means the Spring 2025 deadline is **Monday**, **May 19!**

How Do I Complete an Assessment?

- 1) Select a <u>rubric</u> that makes sense for your course—you have lots of choices!
 - one of our six college-wide rubrics
 - a departmental or course-specific rubric developed for your program
 - Got another rubric of your own you'd like to use for your assessment? Fill
 out this blank template and send it to eLumenSupport@pueblocc.edu!
- 2) Choose an existing <u>assignment</u>, <u>project</u>, <u>or activity</u> from your class that allows your students to demonstrate the skills described in your rubric.
- 3) Score your students on the assignment according to the rubric you selected.
- 4) Log into our assessment platform, <u>eLumen</u>, and <u>enter</u> your students' scores.

PCC Portal (eLearning tab); Quick Links on PCCAssess.com; or direct Web URL: pueblocc.elumenapp.com—Username = S number; password is separate from other PCC accounts. Set (or reset) your password with the "Forgot Password?" link and your PCC email!

Why don't I see my classes?

Confirm the Faculty role and correct program are selected from the drop-down menus at the top. If your "To Do" list is empty, switch to the "Courses" tab where you can link a rubric to your class.

How do I add a rubric to my class?

From the "Courses" tab, click the "Find Assessment" button below your class to open the library of available rubrics!

How do I make sure my assessment is complete?

Go to the "Courses" tab and look for the green checkmark to verify that all students have been scored completely—don't forget to check "Not Assessed" (N/A) for any who dropped or didn't do the assignment!
