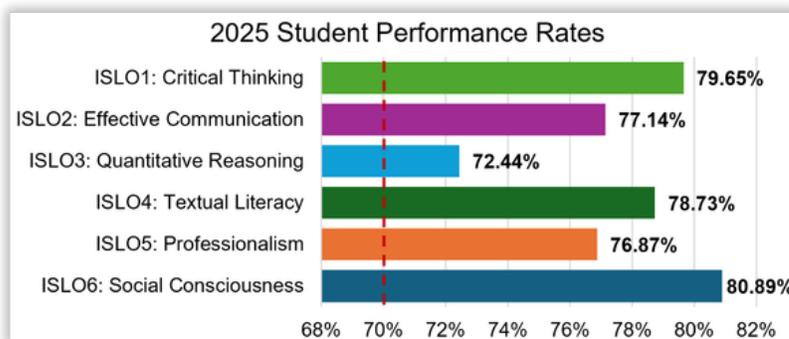

2025 Cycle Initial Results

This past year showed strong student performance across all ISLOs, with particular strengths in Social Consciousness and Critical Thinking, and an **overall achievement rate of 77.89%**—well above our target of 70%. Quantitative Reasoning remains our key opportunity area for targeted supports—think focused faculty development and curriculum alignment.

Faculty participation also rose meaningfully since 2024!

Full-Time: 94.3% (+3.8%), Part-Time: 72.7% (+2.3%), **Overall: 81.3% (+4.0%)**
